### Don't Forget

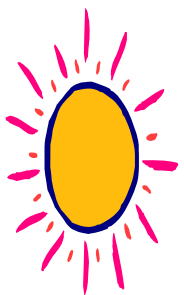
We will be venturing outside as often as possible, so appropriate outer clothing will be needed daily.

### ?? Summer ??

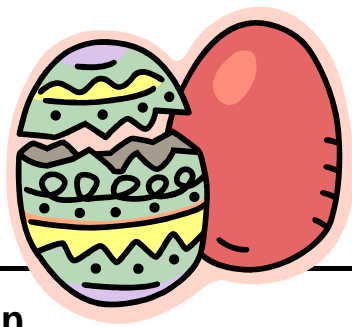

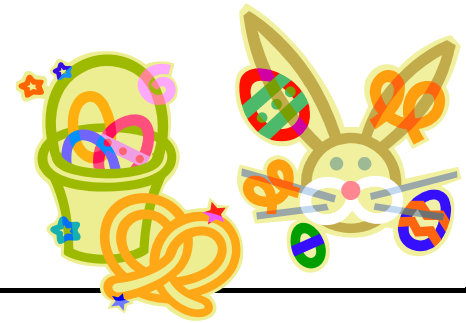
### Smile
